

May 26, 2018

Meeting called to order at 10:15am by Jeff Carter. There were 62 members in attendance.

We have new members who introduced themselves. Welcome!

Treasury report was unavailable during the meeting. A motion was made by Kristin Pavliscak to table the treasury report until the July meeting.

Old Business

Pat Adams had a Consumers employee tighten the cable to the light pole. It is now secured.

John Gabor has ordered the boulders for the tree line. We are waiting for them to be delivered.

A motion was made to accept old business by Jim Thompson, seconded, all approved.

New Business

A member asked how often the County comes out to take care of our roads because hers is in bad shape. Another member mentioned they read that the County grades and brines 4 months a year. We need more gravel on the roads because the grading is not filling the pot holes.

Pat Adams went to the Township meeting and the Road Commission was there. The Road Commission suggested to upgrade the road but this would add a mileage to the property owners. Pat said he could find out how much that mileage would be for each owner. A member is concerned about upgrading because drivers go fast as it is and at least the pot holes slow most down. Pat Adams will find out how much it is and we will decide if we want it added to elections.

A member asked if we could remove the crown at the top of the road along Canal Rd. Other members were against it because there are too many issues with doing it and would cost the Association too much money. Any member is welcome to put together a committee to find out the cost to do the work and if we can do it on our roads because it is believed they are County roads, not private roads. Pat Adams mentioned if we do the upgrade to the roads, it will take care of the issue.

Jeff Carter mentioned there has been talk about replacing the posts that are at the top of the beach area. He suggested a motion be made to purchase a split-rail fence to install there instead. Another member suggested boulders instead because they are maintenance free. A motion was made by Kristin Pavliscak to spend no more than \$500 to purchase and install a split-rail fence at the top of the beach area, seconded, most approved and two not approved.

The boat launch's new crushed asphalt seems to be working very well. We need to finish the area between where it ends and the concrete boat launch. A motion was made to finish it, seconded, all approved.

A member asked about the weed treatment in the lake. Norm Sanders said he talked to the Township and they are supposed to be spraying again around the 4th of July. It is done annually.

Dori said someone took the 2 volleyballs from the beach. If anyone sees them please ask them to be returned. One is red and white speckled (new) and the other is black and white (older and looks like a soccer ball).

Brian and Kristin Pavliscak have decided to leave their positions. An election needs to take place for the Secretary position. We also need a new boat dock person. Tim Judy will take over the boat docks. Eric Sparks has been elected to Secretary.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 11:27am by Jim Thompson, seconded, all approved.
