

*South Cranberry Lake Association Minutes  
from Meeting of May 27, 2006*

Meeting was called to order by Jeff Carter, President at 10:10am. There were approximately 40 members in attendance.

Treasury Report was read by Bonnie Foote. Balance in the fund is \$2,537.35. The Gypsy Moth fund balance is \$837.37. Expenses were as follows:

Pump Priming - \$85.00  
Postage - \$99.30  
Grass Cutting - \$150.00  
Propane - \$292.22  
Consumers - \$1,228.96

Jeff Carter motioned to approve the treasury report, seconded, all approved.

Jeff Carter spoke about keeping vehicles off the walkway by the canal.

Jeff Carter spoke about the several break-ins last year. Joyce Gleason has talked to the sheriff department and they did not have any reports of problems during the winter. The Deputy told Joyce they have started a neighborhood watch, which she is heading up. Her hours have changed, however, and no one will be patrolling from 12pm-4am. Jeff Carter thanked everyone who worked on the clubhouse last year.

Norm Sanders stated we were promised 5 years ago to get a fire hydrant down by the canal. There is no fire hydrant available right now. Please call the township offices to express your concerns.

Jeff Carter asked if anyone wanted to volunteer to put together the 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic. No one volunteered so Joyce Gleason suggested we not have it.

Norm Sanders stated there were large concrete blocks tossed into the canal at the boat launch. Many trailers have been getting caught on them. Volunteer offered to try and get them out after the meeting.

The lack of membership in the association was brought up. There may be a way to request a special assessment for property owners to pay the association dues. Bonnie Foote suggested someone look into this further.

Jeff Carter talked about Tim Driver resigning as Vice President. Bonnie Foote mentioned her resignation as Treasurer. We will need to fill these positions. We will have an election for these at the 4<sup>th</sup> of July meeting. The board will appoint the new members.

Jackie Cross mentioned our neighborhood is involved in the Marine Watch. If you see someone speeding, being reckless, or doing something illegal you should call the sheriff's office.
